PROGRAM ANALYST

Experience: At least eight (8) years of experience in defense acquisition program management related to weapon systems acquisition and life cycle management; and a minimum of four (4) years out of eight (8) years of recent work experience related to international acquisition programs.

Demonstrated experience in the development, management and execution of international cooperative projects/programs. Possess exceptional written and verbal communication skills.

Demonstrated knowledge of the principles, policies, and practices of system acquisition to plan, organize, and coordinate critical aspects of the development, production, deployment, and sustainment of systems, subsystems, and equipment.

CONFIGURATION MANAGEMENT ANALYST

Responsibilities: Analyze program requirements, status, budget and schedules. Perform program management, technical, or business case analyses. Participate as a member of and/or supports the specified Program Integrated Product Teams (IPTs); and IPT directed business meetings. Collect, complete, organize and interpret technical data and financial information relating to aircraft acquisition and product programs. Track program/project status and schedules. Apply policies and procedures for financial planning.

Education: BS or BA degree form an accredited university in Engineering, Science and Technology, Business Management or a degree relevant to the position. Allowable Substitution: An AS or AA degree from an accredited university and an additional four (4) years of experience; or an additional eight (8) years of experience may be substituted for a BS or BA degree. Experience: At least six (6) years program experience; a minimum of three (3) years out of the prior six (6) years of program experience must include aircraft systems configuration management.

Demonstrated program experience in the military aircraft configuration management process must include: configuration identification, control, audit, and status; DOD configuration management policies, procedures, review cycles, instructions and standards; engineering change proposal evaluations.

Demonstrated CM experience with development, production, ancillary equipment, ground support equipment, test and evaluation, and fleet operations of a DoD acquisition aircraft program.

Assist with the execution of data initiatives that require senior level attention and leadership. Exhibit an extremely well informed and high level dialogue and decorum that reflects a diplomatic and professional communication and interaction within and outside of the organization. Understanding of the organization and organizational goals. Promote team building and process improvements to maximize efficiency and effectiveness of the OCIO. Streamline processes and break down barriers when needed.

Education: MS or MA from an accredited university in a Computer Science, Engineering or related Information Technology or Business Management degree. Allowable Substitution: A BS or BA degree from an accredited university and an additional four (4) years of experience can be substituted for an MS or MA degree.

Experience: At least ten (10) years' experience in defense acquisition program management related to weapon systems acquisition and life cycle management; and a minimum of five (5) years out of 10 years of recent work experience related to international acquisition programs.

SENIOR CONTINUOUS PROCESS IMPROVEMENT ANALYST

Responsibilities: Perform critical program management, technical, or business analysis of major DoD acquisition systems and provides recommendations for the JPO Continuous Process Improvement (CPI) core team. Provide support in the development and implementation of process improvement initiative and in problem solving using CPI tool sets. Provide program analysis support for efficiency and effectiveness within the organization, assisting and identifying causes of systemic inefficiencies and isolating them through the use of CPI methodologies such as Lean, Six Sigma, and Theory of Constraints.

Education: MS or MA degree from an accredited university in in Science, Math, Engineering, Business, Management or a degree relevant to the position.

Allowable Substitution: A BS or BA degree from an accredited university and an additional three (3) years of relevant experience can be substituted for an MS or MA degree. Assist in the timely preparation/ coordination of procurement packages/requests to include Request for Proposals, Statements of Work (SOWs), Contract Data Requirements Lists (CDRLs), Certificates of Urgency, Justifications and Approvals (JandAs), and other acquisition documents. Participate in and support acquisition planning meetings. Identify and plan acquisition efforts in accordance with policies and procedures across all levels in achievement of program milestones taking into account tailoring and waiver processes to maximize acquisition system efficiency. Assist in drafting, developing, and coordinating executive level briefings, correspondence, and data calls, as well as prepare input to and coordinate staffing papers and staffing packages in response to any number of executive level inquiries.
